Consider how you want to praise His name. What do you love about God? Pray for God to be honored by all people.

A time to ask God to accomplish His will in your world. Consider circumstances, relationships, and attitudes that are out of line with God's ways. In your life and others. Where do you want to see His will done today? What do you need to surrender?

Give us this day our daily bread.

A time to ask what you need for today.

Consider physical, emotional, spiritual, and mental needs.

What are you facing today? How do you want God to provide?
